BUSINESS DISTRICT PARKING PERMITS

RULES AND REGULATIONS 2015

The Business District Parking Permit Program is a program provided by the Dormont Borough Council.

Adherence to these rules and regulations will simplify the administration of the Program and eliminate problems for permit holders. Violation of the rules and regulations could result in revocation of the permit.

1. Eligibility and Rates

- a. Every applicant for a permit will be required to show a proof of residency or employment at the address for which they are applying.
 - b. Any owner, manager, or employee of a business and any resident who resides in the business district in the Borough of Dormont is eligible to purchase a permit at a rate of \$75 per month.
 - c. Any resident of Dormont that does not reside in the business district or is not the owner, manager, or employee of a business in the business district is eligible to purchase a permit at a rate of \$85 per month.
 - d. Any person that is not a resident of Dormont and does not own, manage, or is employed by a business located within the Borough is eligible to purchase a permit at a rate of \$95 per month.⁹
2. The permit may be used in any Borough metered parking lot and certain streets listed on the 2nd page.
 3. The permit must be hung from the rear view mirror so that the month is clearly visible from the front windshield. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure that the permit is properly displayed.
 4. A permit is valid for one calendar month. The price of the permit is NOT prorated if purchased after the first day of the month. Permits expire on the last day of the month. If a permit holder fails to purchase a permit by the fifth (5th) day of the month, that permit may be sold to someone on the waiting list or, if there is no one on the waiting list to the first person who requests a permit. Dormont Business owners, managers, or employees will receive first preference for new permits or on the waiting list.
 5. The permit exempts payment of the meter fee in the designated municipal parking lots. Rush hour parking restrictions on West Liberty Avenue still apply for applicable streets.
 6. All permits will be numbered and may be purchased up to three (3) months in advance. REMEMBER the proper permit must be displayed each month. If the proper month is not displayed, a parking ticket will be issued.
 7. Should a permit be stolen, the permit holder is responsible for filing a report with the Dormont Police Department. You will be charged for replacement of stolen or lost permits. The replacement charge will be pro-rated based on the number of weeks remaining in the month.
