**Monday, April 18, 2022 – Friday, April 29, 2022**

County Executive Rich Fitzgerald and Pittsburgh Mayor Ed Gainey are leading an effort to provide aid to the people of Ukraine.

## **Please collect the following items to assemble into a kit:**

- (1) 1-Gallon Resealable Plastic Bag
- (1) Travel Size Deodorant (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Travel Size Shampoo (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Travel Size Conditioner (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Travel Size Body Wash (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Travel Size Lotion (no longer than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Travel Size Hand Sanitizer (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Full Size Toothbrush
- (1) Travel Size Toothpaste (no larger than 3.4 ounces)
- (1) Lip Balm (1.5 inches in length/ 0.5 inch in diameter)
- (1) Pack of Travel Size Flushable Wipes
- (1) Pack of Travel Size Tissues
- (2) Tampons
- (4) Sanitary Pads

**Individual personal care items can also be donated, but kits are preferred.**

**1. Use packing tape to secure the lids of the liquid items.**

**2. Place in the resealable bag and zip it closed.**

**3. Drop off your donations at one of the collection sites below.**
